Entry forms received after the midnight of March 10th, 2012 will automatically be directed to Open Courses.

By submitting their entry forms competitors agree on Rule No. 43 of CBO Foot Orienteering Regulations.

“Rule 43 – Those competitors participating in an event are responsible for the risks and accidents they may suffer while travelling to it or when running their courses. Competitors or their clubs are responsible for insurance policies (insurance contract).

Minors must have parents or other adult responsible permission. It should be in written and signed.

Relay entries have a specific entry form. Provide information regarding your team members and team class. Entry fee for each team is 7.00€. Relay classes are Junior (ages 16, 18 20), Adult (ages over 21), Master (ages over 35), Senior (ages over 45). You can also entry mixed teams. It means men and women in the same team; however they must belong to the same age group. For instance; you cannot register a team as Mixed Master team with one participant who belongs to different age group (younger).

MODEL EVENT: Reservations by email only. Send your request to secretaria.cobra@gmail.com. Deadline is March 10th, 2012. Fee is R\$5.00 (3.00€) per map and it must be paid upon receiving it at the model event place. ONE MAP, ONE COMPETITOR – NO EXCEPTIONS.

4. EMBARGOED AREAS

All areas surrounding the city of Diamante do Sul and Cascudo Community are now embargoed and any kind of training is forbidden from the date this bulletin is published until and including the competition days. See the sketch in No 13 below.

5. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE COMPETITION SITES

Weather: Guaraniáçu has a subtropical climate. In March and April the temperature ranges from 18° to 27° C.

Training opportunities: There are some areas for training near Guaraniáçu and Cascavel. Please inform in your interest in doing so in your entry form.

Model Event – Community of Soligo

Barzotto Farm – Distant 12Km from Guaraniáçu downtown, following through BR 277 highway towards Curitiba. Leaving the highway there will be 1.2Km of an unpaved road. The map area has the same characteristics described on the maps for Long and Middle courses.

- You should make a reservation if you want to participate. See “Model Event” at No. 3 above.

Relay – Community of Cascudo

- Santa Ana Farm – It belongs to Decor Pedra Company from Cascavel-PR

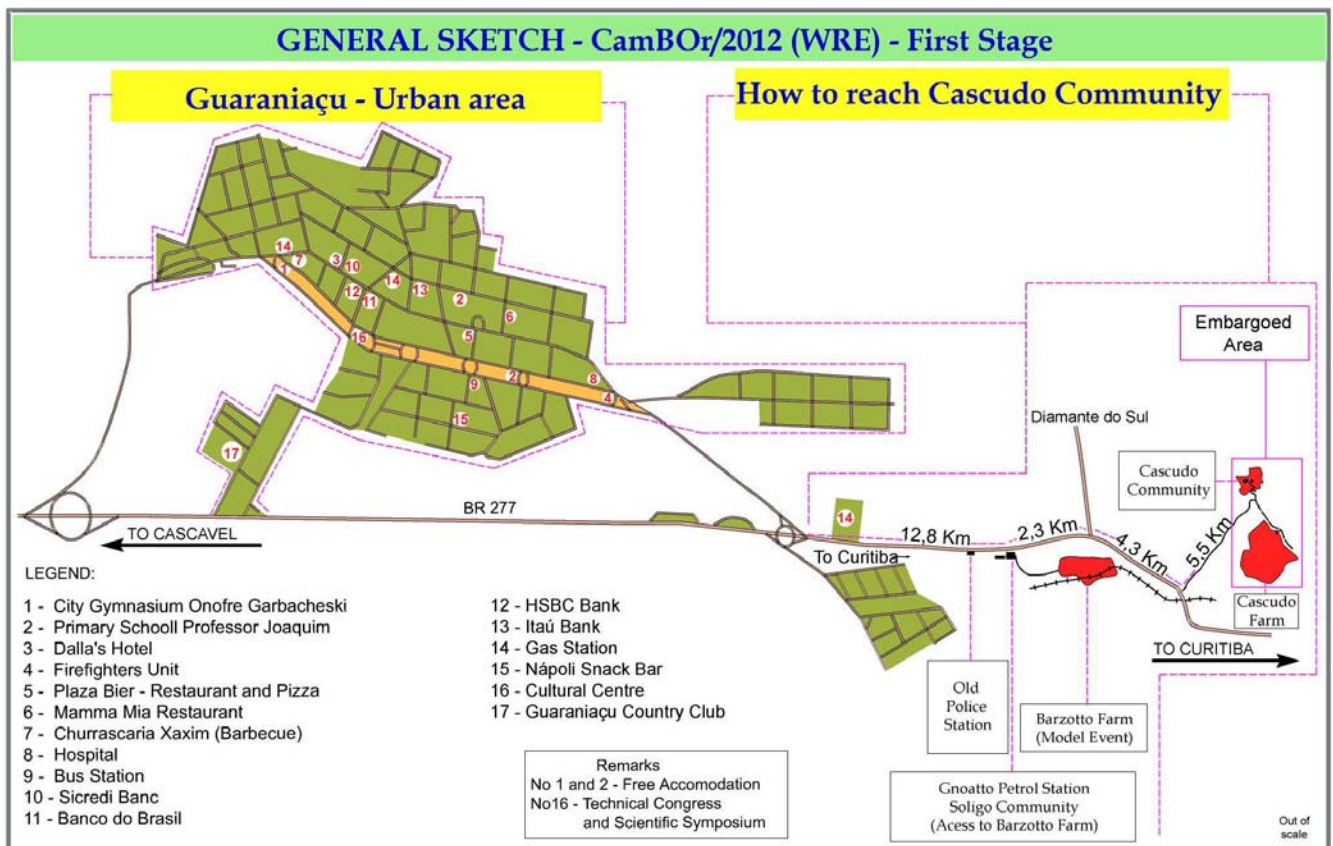
It is about 25 km away from Guaraniãçu driving towards Curitiba on BR 277 highway. From the highway there is about 5.5km of an unpaved road. The farm has a community pavilion, which is typical of countryside cities in Paraná. It also has a small chapel, but a few areas for protecting you from the sun; on the other hand, it has a large grass area where the delegations may place their tents. The Organising Committee will also provide large tents to shelter the athletes. They will be in position during the whole event.

Long and Middle Courses- Community of Cascudo

- Cascudo Farm – It belongs to Andrade & Martins Company from Ibema-PR:

It is also about 25 km from Guaraniãçu driving towards Curitiba on BR 277 highway. It also has about 5.5km of an unpaved road. There is no parking area inside the farm; therefore, all participants should walk or be transported by the organising committee from the community until the start area. Smoking is forbidden inside the farm area due to company’s regulation and the vegetation characteristics.

6. RULES AND GUIDELINES

The competition will follow the IOF Foot Orienteering Rules. It will also follow the CBO Rules for Foot Orienteering, the Rules for the Brazilian Orienteering Championships and the CBO Rules for Relay Competitions, when applicable.

7. CLASSES

This is an open event and it offers all IOF classes. There are no age restrictions for M/W 21E classes. Should you intend to participate in a class different from M/W 21E, notice that in Brazil classes are also divided in “N” (newcomers), “B” (difficult) and “A” (very difficult). For example: H45B means: Men over 45 – Difficult course. In case of doubts, send an email to the organization.

8. PUNCHING, TIMING AND RESULTS

This event will use the **SportIdent** electronic system.

Athletes who do not own a SI-Card must rent one. Follow instructions at No. 3 above. SI-Card rental must be paid upon registration.

Lost or damaged SI-Cards will be charged and the participant must pay R\$90.00 (38.00€)

9. UNIFORM

In accordance with Rule 127 of the CBO Foot Orienteering Regulations: No spike shoes, however, metal studded shoes are allowed. Legs and arms must be covered. All athletes shall wear number bibs during the courses. The organisation will provide number bibs for foreign participants.

10. LOW COST ACCOMODATION AND CAMPING

Option 1 (Free of charge) – City Gymnasium Onofre Garbacheski. It offers only bathrooms and showers. There will be no mattresses available. It will be open for competitors from March 28th, 2012 (17:00 o'clock) – See location in the sketch.

Option 2 (Free of charge) – City Primary School Professor Joaquim. It offers 16 classrooms and they will be distributed to Clubs and/or groups. The school has bathrooms and showers, but there are no mattresses available. The classrooms will be reserved for competitors from March 30th, 2012 (08:00 o'clock). Option 3 – Camping at Guaraniaçu Country Club – it offers a large area for tents, internal parking area, barbecue places, tables, bathrooms and showers. Make your reservation with Ms. Ivanilde by phone +55 45 3232-1972. Its prices will be informed in bulletin No. 2. See location in the sketch.

11. HOTELS IN GUARANIAÇU

- **Hotel Dalla's** – It offers rooms from R\$30.00 (12.50€) for single rooms. Reservations (phone/fax): +55 45 3232-1288. See location in the sketch.

- **Hotel Moro** – It is Ibema City, 18 Km from Guaraniaçu. It offers double and triple rooms with TV and bathroom. Breakfast, parking area and internet are included in the fee. VISA credit card accepted. Its prices range from R\$70.00 (29.00€) for double rooms to R\$105.00 (44.00€) for triple rooms. Reservations (phone): +55 45 3238 1287.

- **Pousada (In Brazil it is a place for staying overnight)** - At BR 277 highway (in direction to Cascavel – left side) – it is 8 km from Guaraniaçu and has 6 double rooms (one bed) and 4 rooms with two single beds. 11.1 HOTELS IN CASCAVEL – (60 km from Guaraniaçu)

For your convenience we included some hotels from Cascavel. It is a medium-sized city with about 300.000 inhabitants and may also offer extra amusement opportunities.

13. TRANSPORTATION

HOW TO REACH GUARANIAÇU BY AIR:

The nearest airport is in **Cascavel** - 60Km from Guaraniaçu. **TRIP** and **SOL** are regional air companies that fly to Cascavel.

Foz do Iguaçu International Airport – 210 Km from Guaraniaçu.

Curitiba - Afonso Pena International Airport – 440 km from Guaraniaçu.

HOW TO REACH THE COMPETITION SITES – See the sketch above (it is not in scale)

From the Event Centre (Guaraniaçu): Drive through BR 277 highway towards Curitiba. It is about 20Km in the highway and 5.5km in an unpaved road.

Driving time by car is about 20 minutes.

The organisation will provide a bus to transport people from the highway to the competition site (those 5.5 Km of unpaved road).

We recommend drivers to pay close **attention** when crossing the highway at the entrance to the unpaved road. This road entrance is only 100m away from a 90° curve for those coming from Guaraniacu and there is a lot of traffic in that region. For safety reasons we suggest you to drive ahead and find a proper place to make a U turn. The organisation will mark and clearly identify the road entrance with cones on the highway.

Parking – Long and Middle Courses:

At Linha Cascudo Community there will be a proper parking area. From the community to the starting area for Middle and Long courses you should move on foot or by a bus the organisation will provide. Cars and buses are not permitted since there is no parking area near that site.

14. MAPS

Maps are in accordance with ISOM 2000. Scale is 1/10.000 and equidistance is 5m for both Long and Middle distance courses. All competition maps will be offset printed.

Relay Area –Santa Ana Farm - Community of Cascudo

Vegetation: open areas with some small areas of forest (405 and 406).

Landform: Its altitude varies from 650 to 700m. There are several re-entrants and crossable water streams along the area.

Roads and paths: The area has only main roads surrounding the map.

Other details: The area has some crossable water streams and copses. Some fences define pasture areas and divide private properties along the mapped area.

Area for Long and Middle Courses– Cascudo Farm - Community of Cascudo

Vegetation: Eucalyptus and pine trees are predominant. There are some small areas of “green” forest (408 and 410).

Landform: It is a hilly terrain and its altitude varies from 680 to 840m. There are several re-entrants and crossable water streams along the area.

Roads and paths: There are roads surrounding the map and paths crossing the area.

Other details: There are some fences surrounding pasture areas.

Old/training maps near the competition area: To be informed in bulletin No. 2.
